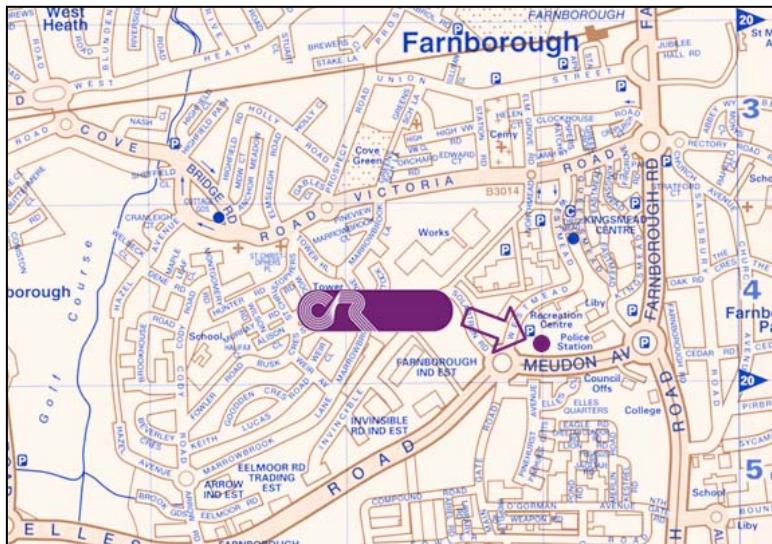
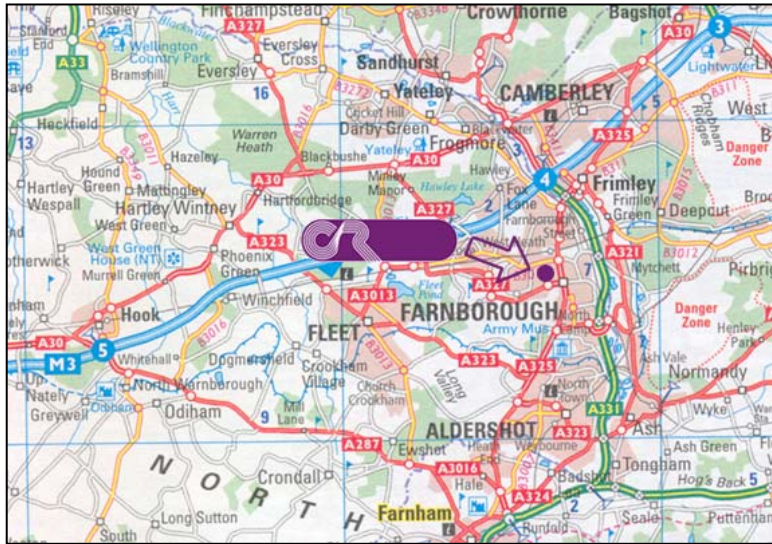

By Car

From London or the North

- Approach via the M3 motorway to Junction 4
- Follow the A331 towards Aldershot and Farnham, leave the A331 at the second exit signed to Farnborough. A325.
- Take the second exit at the first roundabout then cross straight over the next roundabout heading towards the left hand lane.
- Take the first exit at the roundabout junction with the A325.
- Cross straight over the Clock House roundabout.
- Take the second exit at the next roundabout into Meuden Avenue (signed to Reading, Fleet A327)
- Composite Reinforcements office (Westmead House) is on your right and the visitors overflow car park is within the roundabout ahead of you.
- Leave the roundabout at the fourth exit into Westmead, then take the first right and double back in front of the offices.
- Enter the Composite Reinforcements car park by passing through the tunnel on the right hand side. One disabled car park space can be found immediately in front the building.

From the South

- Approach via the M3 motorway to Junction 4A sign posted to Fleet.
- Continue across the roundabout and double back over the motorway.
- Keep to the left over two further roundabouts and cross the bridge over the railway, bearing into summit Avenue.
- Cross straight over the next three roundabouts into Ively Road.
- Cross over the next roundabout (Monkey Puzzle Public House on the left) and then turn left at the following roundabout into Elles Road.
- Cross straight over the next roundabout.
- At the next roundabout (named Sulzer roundabout) the Composite Reinforcements car park is located within this roundabout.
- Take the second turning in to Westmead continue as above. ***

By Train

- From London Waterloo – Basingstoke – Southampton. Trains bring you to Farnborough (main) station.
- Lines from other areas come to Farnborough North or Farnborough North Camp.

From Heathrow

- Taxi to Farnborough or take the "railair" link Heathrow – Woking
- then by train from Woking to Farnborough main line railway station.
